Mr. Waterman presented an update on e-rate Special Construction. There were 2 bids submitted; by Cox Communications and OSHEAN. Mr. Waterman explained his recommendation of OSHEAN for the project. The bids came in much less than projected. The presentation included:

Mr. Blasbalg asked Mr. Waterman questions about e-rate. He noted that this is a major expenditure which is not budgeted but would come out of fund balance. He suggested that it may be best to think over this matter and vote on it at the next meeting.

Mrs. McGauvran pointed out that the District has so many other capital needs.

Mr. Jones noted that this is an example of the District getting ahead on a project and making an investment in future needs.

Ms. Stevens said that she like the fact that the project included disaster recovery.

Dr. Auger said that the District is expanding its use of technology. This plan would allow for control over expansion.

Mrs. McGauvran asked whether the high school offers online courses.

Dr. Humbyrd explained that there are some online and RI network courses offered. There are plans to expand these offerings.

Mrs. King noted that this project has a potential return on investment.

Mrs. Hoskins said that she agreed that the District needs the expanded capacity for technology and warned that by not looking forward, we risk ending up with a bottle neck as technology advances.

Mrs. McGauvran said that this construction is the foundation for the District's technology initiative. She added that there is a great reliance on technology and said that the proposal should go forward.

Mr. Jones added that the District should not wait for additional information and clarity from the State.

Mr. Blasbalg thanked Mr. Waterman for the two detailed presentations on e-rate. He offered his support and said that this was a good use of capital funds which lays the foundation for our technology.

Mr. Jones asked what the timeline is for the budget review by the Town.

Mrs. King replied that there is a meeting scheduled for Wednesday night and a budget vote will take place either on Monday, May 1 or Wednesday, May 3.

Mr. Jones asked whether the audit has been completed yet.

Mrs. King replied that it is being worked on but is not yet complete.

C. CIP/Existing Bond/Future Bond

Mrs. King said that there has been a discussion with the Town regarding potential bond amounts and timing. The Town has asked the School Committee to determine the impact of not seeking General Assembly bonding authority until 2018, with a Town referendum in November 2018. Projects would be started in summer 2019. Mrs. King said that realistically this would be the earlier timetable for tackling large projects. There are smaller projects that will be addressed sooner and paid for with fund balance.

2. Long-term Planning

Mrs. King explained that a Town Council Member has asked for an estimate on the cost to renovate Wickford Middle School (WMS) and asked the School Committee whether they want to seek an estimate from the District's architect.

Mrs. McGauvran noted that the NESDEC study did not recommend a renovation of WMS.

Mrs. King concurred and said that a WMS renovation would not address other school needs.

Mrs. McGauvran added that it is expensive to come up with an estimate and it must be part of a complete review.

Mr. Blasbalg provided context and said that the question was raised during a discussion of potential future closing of WMS. The renovation of WMS is not part of the long term plan and it is too costly to renovate.

Mrs. King said that she has spoken with the architect and he is hesitant to give a square foot cost estimate to renovate an old building without specifics on what renovations would be included.

Mr. Blasbalg pointed out that the problems with WMS are inherent to its last century design and it cannot be configured to be the type of school that the District wants. He added that it is not worth spending money on a renovation review.

Mr. Jones said that the Committee has no intent on spending any money on an option that is not part of the long term plan. He added that ideally the building would be turned over to the Town at some point. Mr. Jones said that there needs to be a consolidation of schools and that a review of WMS takes time and attention away from addressing the real problems.

Dr. Auger provided a history of past efforts to secure bonds for WMS renovations.
